Request for Proposal Process

- RFP Released on January 3, 2018
- Submission period 30 days (proposals due on February 22, 2018)
- Posted on Workforce Investment Board of Will County's website on January 3, 2018
- Published notice in Joliet Herald News on January 3, 4, and 5, 2018
- Emailed notice of RFP to all contacts on WIB mailing list (1995 email addresses)
- All questions received by January 17, 2018 were answered and responses posted on the Workforce Investment Board of Will County's website on January 27, 2018

Proposal Review Process

- Four proposals were received by the deadline of 4:00 pm on February 22, 2018
 - In The Door
 - National Able Network
 - ResCare
 - Workforce Services Division of Will County
- Evaluation team of 8 reviewed and rated proposals on March 21, 2018

- Evaluation results:
 - In The Door – 64 points
 - National Able Network – 71 points

Selection Process

- Pre-Award Risk Assessment completed for Will County on February 23, 2018
- Recommendation and MOU for One-Stop Operator award to Workforce Services Division of Will County approved by the Workforce Investment Board on April 9, 2018 and the Will County Board on May 17, 2018

One-Stop Operator MOU

- One year MOU with possibility of 2 additional one-year extensions (PY18, PY19, and PY20) based on performance and funding
- PY18 MOU = \$265,464
