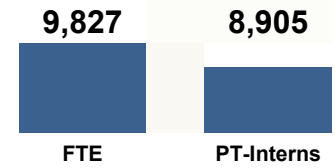


JOB POSTINGS – WILL COUNTY, IL February 2023

The Workforce Investment Board of Will County analyzed recent postings pulled from internet job boards to develop an understanding of current job demand and employer needs. The jobs summarized here were active online from 2/1/23 through 2/28/23. The data source, Jobs EQ, Real-Time Intelligence, uses web spider crawler technology to scour employer sites & online job boards and assigns an occupational code to each job posting. Active postings may have been posted before current time period. *Job may be listed as both full-time & part-time, resulting in the sum exceeding the single total.
